Thank you for your interest in applying for a site at our 2026 Show!

Please find enclosed the 2026 Malanda Show 'General Conditions of Contract' and 'Site Application' Forms. We advise you to give this your immediate attention so that we may secure a suitable area for you.

Site applications for the 2026 Malanda Show close on **Friday, 15th May 2026**. Please ensure that you read the information carefully and complete all sections of the application fully. Forms must be completed and returned to the Show Office via email or in person by the closing date.

Expectations and Offers

Each site vendor will be entitled to **three (3) entry passes**; additional passes will need to be paid for by the applicant.

Vehicle Access to the showgrounds is extremely limited and we ask that throughout the duration of the show, vehicle movement is limited. If vehicles cannot fit in the space allocated, they are to be off the grounds or parked in the rear camping area. If you will need to use your vehicle during show operating hours please park off the grounds.

Camping for vendors is permitted, behind site allocation, **should there be space available**. Please notify the Show Society of your camping arrangements in your application so we can find suitable space for you as we cannot guarantee there will be sufficient room for everybody. We strongly suggest utilizing the caravan park that operates in Malanda for your accommodation needs.

Site allocation is at the discretion of our committee. We do consider requests; however, we cannot guarantee space will be obtainable. Sites will only be secured once payment has been made.

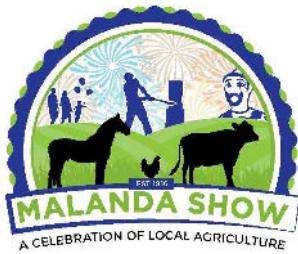
Please indicate what power and water supply is required, refer to Clause 18.

If you are attending our show, you must commit to being on site for the entire duration of our show from **Friday 12noon until Sunday 3pm**.

The Malanda Pavilion remains inaccessible; therefore, we cannot offer indoor space in 2026.

Note: Malanda Show's Major Sponsor, Dairy Farmers, have negotiated the right to 'Exclusive Supply' of dairy products on the Malanda Showgrounds during the 2026 Show. This is a part of the Conditions of Contract (Clause 10) and it is the responsibility of Site holders to ensure their enterprise, where applicable, adheres to this Site Contract requirement.

OUTDOOR SPACE

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. IMPORTANT

Site application must be received by the Malanda Show Society by 15th May 2026. Full payment of the site fee is due before 26th June 2026. Prompt payment is always appreciated.

2. SITE ALLOCATIONS:

The Malanda Show Society has final say on site allocations and no discussion will be entered into regarding where sites are allocated.

Specific measurement, in metres, must be nominated. When measuring vans, include the space taken by towbars, etc., and with tents, the space taken by tent ropes and pegs. Space will be allocated according to the square/rectangular measurements given on your application form. All vehicles/tents/camping **MUST** fit within the dimensions given on the application; any additional space taken will be measured and charged accordingly. Please ensure you book sufficient frontage and depth to suit your business and camping requirements.

3. STALL HOLDER PASSES:

Stall holders are entitled to three (3) passes per site – extra 3-day passes can be purchased for \$40 each.

4. DISPLAY SET-UP:

Outdoor display stands must be set up prior to 10:00 am on the Friday of the Show (26th June).

5. DISPLAY DISMANTLING:

Displays, stalls or fixtures must not be dismantled before 3:00pm on Sunday, the last day of the Show (28th June). Goods and materials are to remain until the official 'closing time' of the show. All Fixtures, vehicles and materials are to be removed, and the area completely vacated no later than three (3) days after the Show (1st July).

6. STALL REGULATIONS:

All Stalls must be constructed and maintained in accordance with the appropriate state and city departmental regulations. It is the responsibility of the applicant to see that all permits and inspections have been obtained and carried out. Such certificates must be furnished when requested by the Malanda Show Society.

ALL FOOD VEHICLES/STALLS MUST HAVE A CURRENT CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION AND CERTIFICATE OF LICENCE.

7. SUB-LETTING:

The allocated site is to be used only for the purpose specified on the application and by the person or firm to whom it has been allocated. No sub-letting will be permitted without the written permission of the Malanda Show Society.

8. RAFFLES/GAMBLING:

The sale of raffle tickets, Lott, Chance or Art Union tickets is **strictly prohibited**, except on those sites specifically allocated for that purpose. Exhibitors must not allow their areas to be used for fundraising raffles even though the exhibitor may be sponsoring a charity.

9. SITE AND SELLING RESTRICTIONS:

The site holder must confine their business to the purpose accepted on the Site Application. No selling, canvassing, hawking or distribution of print or other matters will be permitted. Canvassing and hawking will lead to closure of your site and forfeiture of site fees paid. The Malanda Show Society reserves the right to forbid the sale of any line for which specific application has not been made.

10. FOOD:

The selling of the following food lines is NOT PERMITTED, as they are exclusive Showmen's Guild lines: Fairy Floss, Dagwood Dogs, Waffles, Doughnuts, Toffee Apples and Snow Cones.

The sale of any dairy product other than Dairy Farmers is NOT PERMITTED. Dairy Farmers has the right to 'Exclusive Supply' on the Malanda Show Grounds during the Malanda Show. Site holders have the option of contacting local franchisees for supply of Dairy Farmers products or alternatively seeking supply from other Dairy Farmers outlets.

11. SHOWBAGS:

The selling of Showbags of any description is restricted to existing Showbag stalls.

12. ADVERTISING SIGNS:

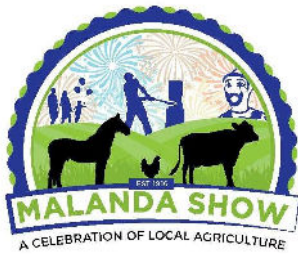
The display of approved advertising signs of any description is restricted to the area occupied by the vendor. No permanent signs are to be erected.

13. EXHIBITOR CONDUCT:

The site holder and their employees are to conduct themselves in an orderly and respectful manner while on the Showgrounds. Alcoholic beverages must not be consumed on sites by exhibitors or employees.

14. OFFENSIVE MATERIAL:

Executive members of the Show Society have the right to enter sites and remove any article, sign, picture or printed matter, which, in their opinion, may cause offence to the public or the officials of the Malanda Show Society.

15. DISPLAY FASTENINGS:

Under no circumstances shall vendors fasten items in a permanent fashion in their area without first obtaining authority from the Malanda Show Society. All fixtures are to be temporary in nature and removed at the conclusion of the Show.

16. DISPLAY LAYOUT:

The Malanda Show Society undertakes to rent the site and/or facility in its present condition. All subsequent plumbing, carpentering and electrical requirements will be the responsibility of the leasing vendor.

17. SOUND SYSTEMS:

P.A. Systems, projectors, and sound units must be governed so that their volume is not objectionable to other exhibitors or show patrons. The Show Society maintains the right to disconnect these systems upon receipt of a legitimate written complaint.

18. ELECTRICAL:

If more than one (1) 10-amp power point is required, a four-outlet power board is allowable on the condition that it has an overload facility. All leads must be tested & tagged, sit clear of the ground and not impede flow of pedestrians and vehicles on the grounds. **Double adaptors are no longer permitted.**

19. RUBBISH DISPOSAL:

Vendors should empty their rubbish into the rubbish receptacles provided by the Malanda Show Society, after the Show closes, daily. Site holders are responsible for all cleaning on, around and adjacent to their site for the entire duration of the Show.

20. ENQUIRIES:

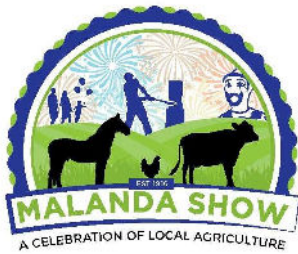

21. LOSS OR DAMAGE:

The Malanda Show Society will not be held responsible for any loss of, or damage to, stock-in-trade, materials, personal possessions etc. of vendors from any cause.

22. INDEMNITY:

The Malanda Show Society will not be responsible for any accident which may be caused through or by the vendor, or which may happen in connection with their business. The Site Holder shall save the Malanda Show Society, harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from every such accident.

24. WORKPLACE HEALTH & SAFETY REGULATIONS:

Written and signed assurance is required from vendors to certify that any temporary structures, vans, equipment etc., and any activity that takes place on or adjacent to your site, complies in all respects with Workplace Health & Safety Legislation. This includes, but is not limited to, testing and tagging of electrical equipment and fitting of earth leakage detection devices. You are also required to provide a written report of all accidents and/or dangerous occurrences.

25. ALTERATIONS:

The Malanda Show Society reserves the right to alter these General Conditions of Contract at any time and without further reference to Vendors.

- ✘ Playing Cards (nude or lurid)
- ✘ Pressure Pack Snow
