CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

Entries Close 12.00 midday Friday 28th June, 2024. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Judging will commence 12.00 midday Saturday 29th June, 2024.

1. Entries must be the product of the person entering
2. Each exhibitor must complete the official entry form, which along with the fees must accompany the entry.
3. Each bottle must be identified with a tie label with the entrant's name, type of wine or beer and class.
4. Please supply three (3) bottles per particular batch of brew.
5. Bottles must be clean & free from chips and damage.
6. Brews entered in the wrong class will be judged in the class in which they have been entered.
7. The Judge/s may disqualify an entry if it is considered that the entry is falsely represented. The exhibitor of such an entry may have all other entries disqualified from the competition.
8. An exhibitor shall be bound by the decisions of the Malanda Pastoral, Agricultural & Industrial Society Inc, and the Judge/s and Steward in charge of the Section. No disputes will be entered into.
9. All entries and fees shall become the property of the Malanda Pastoral, Agricultural & Industrial Society Inc.
10. The Malanda Pastoral, Agricultural & Industrial Society Inc and the Judge/s and Steward in charge of the Section will not be held responsible for the loss of, or damage to, an entry, entry form, or fees. Nor shall they be responsible for entries entered in the wrong class or incorrectly labelled.
11. The Malanda Pastoral, Agricultural & Industrial Society Inc reserves the right to alter these Conditions of Entry at any time without notice.
12. All exhibitors shall be deemed to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry and Schedule of Beer Classes.

Please clearly mark on your entry form and label if the beer entered contains Chili, Ginger or similar spices. Also label any potential allergens such as nuts, milk or milk by-products which your beer may contain.

Points will be awarded as follows:	Drinkability	Max 10 points
	Aroma/Bouquet	Max 10 points
	Body/Flavour	Max 30 points
	TOTAL MAX	= 50 points

Awards will be given in each class for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd places.
