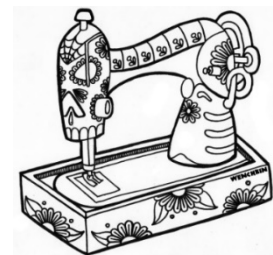

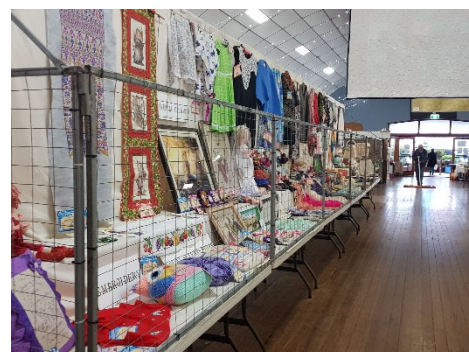

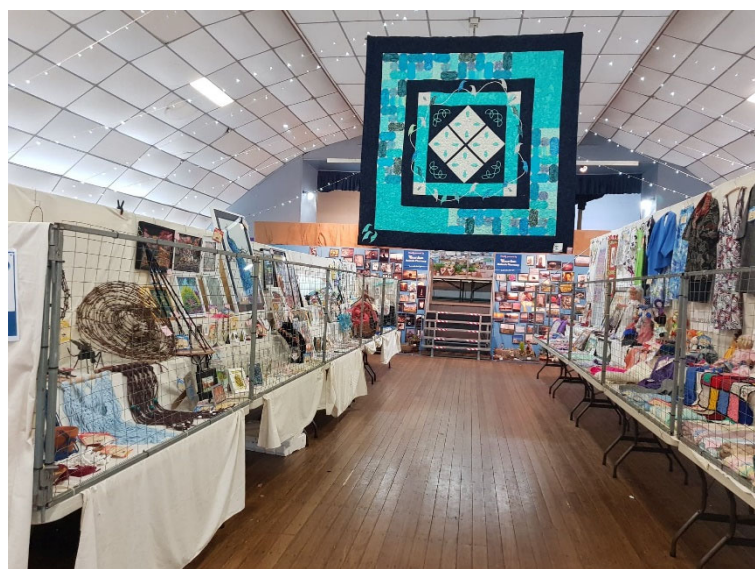

Stewards will be available from 8:30a.m. Wednesday for delivery of exhibits and from 3:30p.m. Sunday for collection of exhibits. **Exhibits will not be handed back for collection if the collector is unable to show an exhibit ticket that matches the corresponding ticket on the exhibit being collected.**

All articles submitted are to be the bona-fide work of the exhibitor and finished within the last 24 months.

All articles submitted for entry are to have a name stitched onto the back *which is to be covered* for the time of the show. All quilts and hangings are to have a 3-inch sleeve attached to the top/back of the article.

Please be mindful that there will be limited space available to display exhibits this year, and as a consequence it may not be possible to display entries fully. Quilts may have to be folded to enable as many entries to be displayed as possible.
