

MALANDA SHOW DAIRY EXHIBITORS 2026.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING LETTER CAREFULLY – IT CONCERNS YOU

The 2026 Malanda Show is just 10 weeks away & you have no doubt been giving consideration to your show team.

Our three dairy judges have been confirmed. Illawarra – Jim Strong Combined Breeds – Robbie Wilson Holstein - Daniel Bacon. Robbie Wilson will judge the “John & Cherie Bevan Memorial Youth Challenge” & “Rabobank Young Judges Competitions” on Friday 26th June 2026.

To ensure the Malanda Show Dairy Section continues to meet the high standards as stated by the Qld Ag Show rules, changes have been necessary to our dairy sections this year.

REGISTRATION OF ANIMALS: All dairy cattle **must be registered** in a Herd Book of the respective breed recognised by the Association for that breed. Heifers entered in the Under 6 Months Class will be exempt from this ruling.

All dairy cattle entered in classes must conform to the policy of each individual Breed Society. Any animal not meeting Breed Society showing policies will be withdrawn. Illawarra exhibits will be accepted under the ICSA Qld Branch showing policy {contact Anne for a copy}.

Any animal owned by a partnership or group of persons, may be entered in the name of the joint owners or, with the written consent of the others, in the name of anyone, or in the joint names of two or more of the co-owners. Letter confirming this to be submitted with your nomination of the animal by 19th June 2026.

All animals to have their Herd Book Number on your nomination form PLUS a photocopy of each registration certificate attached. Nominations will close for the dairy section on Friday 19th June 2026 at 4pm. Substitutions will be not be permitted after close of nominations.

All cattle will be inspected on Friday 26th June 2026 – Tattoos must be legible & the Registration Certificate for each animal will be sighted on inspection. NLIS tags will also be scanned.

YOUTH CHALLENGE: If you have young family members or workers {aged 8 years to 21 years} who may be interested in competing in the “John & Cherie Bevan Memorial Youth Challenge” or the Young Judges Competition, please contact Anne for further details. Nominations for these events also close at 4pm on Friday 19th June 2026 at 4pm with the competition on Friday 26th June 2026 commencing at 8am sharp.

PARADER COMPETITION: The Senior/Intermediate/Junior Parader Classes MAY BE JUDGED SIMULTANEOUSLY {and there is every likelihood this will happen}. Therefore, exhibitors should ensure that each parader has their own heifer for the competition. Sharing of animals is not an option.

To our valued Dairy Exhibitors,

The Malanda Show Society wishes to thank everyone for their ongoing participation in the Dairy section. Malanda Show is a very highly regarded dairy show throughout Australia.

As you would be aware, the Far Northern show season is fast approaching. Therefore, it is timely to communicate with all exhibitors before the upcoming Malanda Show – **26th – 28th June 2026**.

We expect our volunteer stewards and staff to conduct themselves in a professional manner, the same respect is expected of all exhibitors at our event. We are grateful to both exhibitors and volunteers and ask that everyone make the effort to work together as we are all thriving to showcase the best of our respective industries.

This year, we are expecting the return previous exhibitors as well as new exhibitors. With this in mind, there will be VERY LIMITED AREA FOR CAMPING WITHIN THE SHEDS and on the showgrounds. Camping in the campgrounds is also at a premium so please work together. Dairy Exhibitors who wish to camp on the grounds during the show are asked to camp in the designated camping area. Dairy sheds, with exception of the Illawarra Shed, do not have spaces or privacy available for camping. If you are intending to camp during the show, please complete appropriate forms and lodge with the office by the relevant closing date.

The selection of judges across all the sections of the show is at the discretion of the Show Management Committee and may not be from the nominations provided by the various sections involved.

We must congratulate all exhibitors on the presentation of our cattle sheds during show time. In previous years, they have been wonderfully presented, and we hope to maintain this for many years to come. As locals are aware, the continuing wet weather is proving to be challenging for tick control and animal husbandry. Shows are your 'shop window', so please select exhibits that are 'show worthy' to encourage optimistic conversation and a positive perspective around cattle in our area. ***Please leave any animals at home if they have warts or ringworms as these are highly contagious.***

As of 2025, Malanda Show cattle exhibits are growing enormously in popularity. One of the reasons for this is the opportunity for show patrons to walk through all the cattle sheds. Whilst it is not easy to accommodate this amount of public traffic on judging day, please remember that these people are your customers and although it is at times frustrating, we hope we can work together to continue this wonderful PR exercise. This is your opportunity to promote your industry! Signage has been purchased to inform the public of the risks of moving animals and when judging will be happening.

People come to Malanda Show because it is a true agricultural show; show patrons enjoy exploring the sheds and hence we want to ensure stalls are full of animals, ***this includes into Sunday. Please,*** we need more animals to be left at the show for the large number of show patrons coming

through the stalls on Sunday. We expect the majority of your show team on display throughout the entire show and for participating in our Grand Parade on Sunday from 11.30am.

The main income of our society is gate admission from show patrons attending our show and sponsorship from our valued sponsors, so please respect our show patrons and sponsors, after all, they are the people paying your prize money and travel subsidy.

Please consider the amount of bedding required for set up and maintenance throughout the weekend. Kickboards used to keep the shavings within the bedded area look fantastic and keeps bedding in place, however, we ask that these boards are not overly deep to avoid excess use. Peeramom Skips will be removing waste again and have asked that **NO** glass and other rubbish is placed in these waste bins otherwise excess charges will be incurred. ***Please ensure you put waste directly into the skip bins. DO NOT dump it beside the available bin. Please utilise the bins provided for general rubbish.***

MILK DISPOSAL: Following complaints made to the council after the 2023 show, there is to be **NO MILK TIPPED INTO DRAINS**. All milk will need to be removed from the show grounds by the exhibitor.

Double adapters are considered a safety hazard and are no longer allowed to be used in a public place; this includes the Malanda Showgrounds.

Vehicle access on the showgrounds is extremely limited. If it is necessary for you to park on the grounds, you ***will need to park*** in the camping area behind the cattle stalls. Vehicle movement will be restricted on the grounds between the hours of 9am to 4pm. If you need to leave during these hours, ***park outside***. For safety, the speed limit will be 10kph. **YOU MUST PRESENT TICKETS/ARM BANDS AT HORSE GATE ENTRY AND DISPLAY VEHICLE PASS FOR ACCESS.** Please consider pre-purchasing additional tickets – **TryBooking: Malanda Show**. Please be considerate of our volunteers at the entry, it is your responsibility to have an entry ticket on you.

Finally, everyone needs to be mindful of the rules of **no drinking and smoking in the cattle sheds**. This is not a licensed area and you are leaving yourself vulnerable to the consequences of drinking in a public place. Bad behaviour, whether associated with alcohol consumption or not, **will not be tolerated**. The safety of volunteers, exhibitors and patrons are of high importance.

Thank you for taking the time to read this lengthy update. We appreciate the continued support for our wonderful Malanda Show.

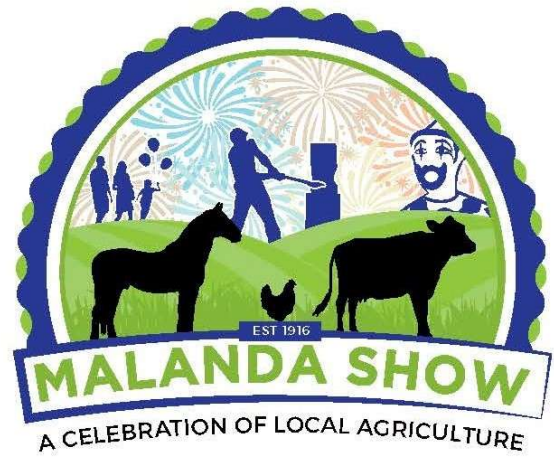
