CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ADMISSION TO SHOWGROUNDS: - Admission to the Malanda Showgrounds is **ONLY free to competitors**. ALL other persons are required to pay admission to enter the Showgrounds.

EXHIBITOR PASSES: - will only be issued on receipt of indemnity forms and full payment of all relevant fees due.

VEHICLE PASSES: - will only be issued to competitors requiring camp sites and stabling. Day Competitors will **NOT** be issued with vehicle passes, DAY PARKING IS AVAILABLE AT THE END OF THOMAS STREET.

INDEMNITY FORMS: – **MUST be completed and lodged by email or at the Nominations Tent PRIOR to competing in any event.**

PRIZE MONEY

- Will **NOT** be paid to Competitors/Exhibitors who have failed to supply signed Indemnity Forms & **Horse Health Declaration Forms PRIOR** to competing in an event.
- Will be paid in Centre Ring

DRESSAGE NOMINATIONS CLOSE – Friday 19th June 2026 at 5p.m., 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE SHOW. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Chief Steward.

NOMINATION CARDS are available for purchase from the Show Office 2 weeks prior to show and at the Nominations Tent from 7am Saturday 27th June 2026 until 11am Sunday 28th June 2026 during the Show. Refunds will **NOT** be issued for unused Nomination Cards

HORSE STALLS AND CAMPING are available for Competitors **ONLY** – To receive Stalls and Camping allocations competitors **MUST** complete the required forms and return them with full payment to the Manager by 5pm on 12th June 2026. Stalls are limited and will be allocated in the order they are paid for. **NO** stalls are available for Stallions, or horses competing in Halter Classes (Class 1D).

ELECTRIC FENCES are NOT permitted. Horse yards may be erected only in designated areas – sites are 4 metre x 4 metre and persons having stable allocations for their horse/s **cannot** also have horse yards.

CAMPING sites are 16 metres x 4 metres – they are for the duration of the show only with electricity available at most sites. **PLEASE NOTE – If you require more area than 16 x 4 metres then you will have to pay for more than one camp site.**

HELMET TAGGING: ALL helmets must be tagged. ALL riders (including Adult riders) at all times when mounted must wear an approved safety helmet. An accredited Helmet Tagger will be on site for the duration of the Show. Please visit the Nominations Tent for details.

SPURS: No spurs other than dummy spurs are to be used in all age events.

MANURE and HAY MUST be placed in the designated manure pit and NOT dumped on walkways between the stables or left in piles outside the stables.

STALLIONS: Can **NOT** be kept on the Showgrounds overnight, be allocated stalls, or compete in the Hack Classes.

The Management Committee reserves the right to add to, substitute, alter or delete any event or condition.

If, in the opinion of the Judge, an exhibit is not worthy of a prize or is out of the class, the Judge has the right to refuse to make an award. **THE DECISION OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL ON ALL POINTS WITHOUT RECOURSE.**

All competitors entering and competing in Section 1 (Horses) do so at their own risk. The Society accepts no responsibility and receives the entries only under these conditions. All entries will be deemed to have been made and received subject to these conditions and to be under the rules of the Malanda Pastoral, Agricultural & Industrial Society Inc., as well as QCAS Rules for Show Societies.

HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL HORSES prior to competing.

COMPETITORS - PLEASE NOTE

1. Dressage will be run under the 2025 Equestrian Australia Dressage Rules. A copy is available from:
https://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/EA%20Dressage%20Rule%20Book%20Janauary%202026_0.pdf
2. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they comply with all EA rules and regulations.
3. **Riders must be aware of the EA rules banning clipping/shaving or modifying sensory hairs (whiskers) or removing or shortening the hair within the rims of the auricle (ears). Non-compliance will result in elimination.**
4. Daisy rowels, tines, notched, serrated edges are not permitted. If disc rowels are used, they must be blunt & smooth (no sharp edges) and free to rotate.
5. Horses can only compete in a maximum of three tests per day, at two (2) consecutive levels (ie Prep/Prelim, Prelim/Novice).
6. One rider per horse applies for the entire event.
7. All helmets must be tagged. An EA Accredited helmet tagger will be available on the day.
8. Test calling is allowed.
9. Horses must start their test inside the Dressage arena.
10. **Horse Health Declaration Forms are to be submitted to the Nominations Tent prior to competing.**
11. Presentations will be done immediately after each class.

EA Accredited Stewards will be officiating at this event to ensure the welfare of horses is upheld and events are conducted safely and as per EA rules. Competitors must follow the directions of the Stewards.

GEAR CHECK: Riders must have a gear check **BEFORE** and **AFTER** each test. If no gear check riders will be eliminated.

GENERAL RULES – SHOW JUMPING

1. All classes conducted in accordance with the 2026 Equestrian Australia show jumping rules
2. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they comply with all EA rules and regulations.
3. All Classes are Maximum of 3 starts per horse per day (**including** the 6 Bar Event).
4. Riders/Horses can compete in either the Junior or the Open Six Bar but not both.
5. Nomination cards can be purchased on the day from the tent near the Hack ring.
6. Article 100 – EA Activity Classification - Official and Closed Equestrian activity conducted under the relevant sport rules may be classified as either Competitive activity, Participation activity or Restricted activity and must abide by the respective conditions as stated below:
7. Competitive Events – Competitors jumping 1.05m and above must be official competitive members of EA and the horse must hold EA Full Horse Registration and
8. Participation Events – for Competitors jumping 1.04m and below, you must be an EA Participant member and the horse must have either a full or a base EA Horse Registration. Competition licences are not required.
9. Dress Code – ratcatcher or collared shirt with tie must be worn. No coloured jodhpurs are allowed - white, cream or beige only. All riders must be dressed according to the EA dress code. Those attired incorrectly will not be eligible to compete. All helmets must be tagged. A jacket is required for the Grand Prix, Class 27.
10. EA Junior Rule applies (refer Art 255.2).
11. If a horse competes HC, it may be competitive the next day of the Show.
12. Please ensure that all horses are well secured before the fireworks commence on Saturday night.

EXPLANATION OF SHOW JUMPING CLASSES

- Art 238.2.1 – One round against the clock.
- Art 238.2.2 – One round with a jump off.
- Art 273 2.2.2. ii, 3.3.1, 4.3– Two rounds against the clock.
- ****Class 27 is the Nutrien Ag Solutions Series. The Series only includes the Malanda Show and the Cairns Show. The point allocation will be as follows: 1st place – 50 points, 2nd place – 40 points, 3rd place – 30 points, 4th place – 20 points, 5th place – 10 points. No additional bonus points will be awarded for starting at Malanda Show. Competitors may compete in Class 27 without taking part in the Nutrien Ag Solutions Series. Both Malanda and Cairns will provide their own prize money for their events as indicated in their schedules. Each Show will provide ribbons for their events 1st to 5th placegetters.**
Nutrien Ag Solutions sponsorship will be awarded at the Cairns Show to the placegetters of the Series as follow: 1st \$425, 2nd \$325, 3rd \$225, 4th \$125, 5th \$100. A sash will be awarded to the overall Series 1st placegetter and ribbons will be awarded for 2nd to 5th place to the overall Series placegetters.

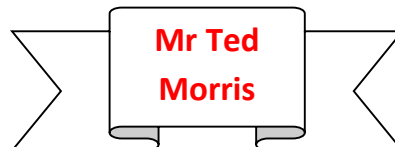

DEFINITIONS

Pony 14 hands and under.

Galloway Over 14.0 hands and not exceeding 15.0 hands must be ridden by riders 12 years & over.

Hack Over 15.0 hands must be ridden by riders 12 years & over.

Maiden An animal which, up to the time of starting the event, has never won a first prize in a hack class in competition at any Agricultural show.

Novice A horse or pony which has never won a Champion Novice or placed first in an Open Class at any Agricultural Show. Class is lost once a horse competes in an Open class and is placed either First, Second or Third, or wins Champion Novice.

Riders: LADY and GENT rider to be 18 years and over on the day of competition.

A NOVICE RIDER is a rider who has never come first in an adult rider class at a registered Show.

In LADY'S HACK and GENT'S HACK, lady or gentleman to ride one horse only.

In PAIR OF HACKS, horses **MAY** be the property of separate owners.

JUNIORS & YOUNG RIDERS. Competitors may take part in competitions and championships for Junior until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 18 years. Junior Riders must wear short boots in all Pony Hack and Rider classes.

Tableland Shire Open to Residents of what were the Eacham, Atherton, & Herberton Shires. Horses to have been domiciled in the appropriate areas of the old shires for the 6 months preceding the Malanda Show.

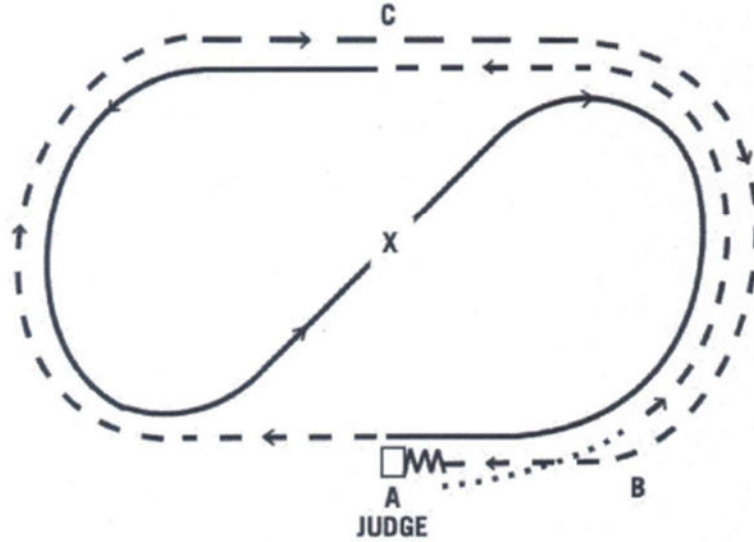

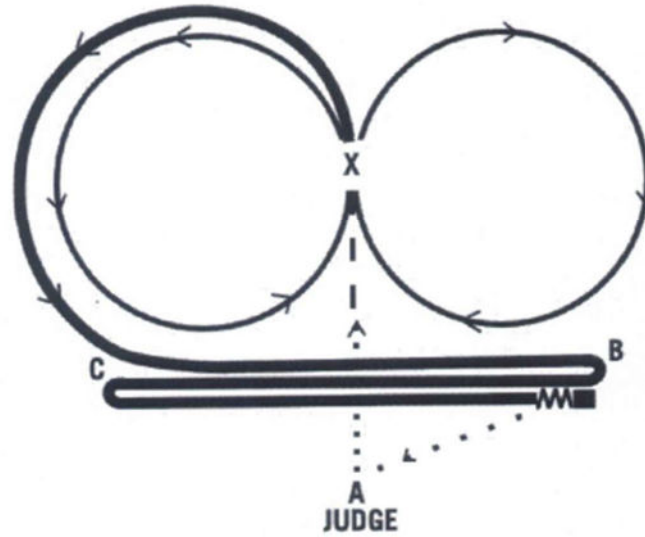

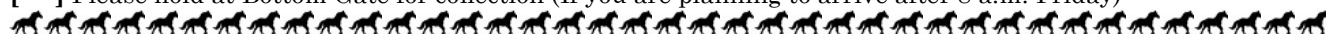
