Malanda Show Queen & Princess Competition

Conditions of Entry

- ❖ Show Queens must be between the ages of 18 – 27 years
- ❖ Show Princesses must be between the ages of 13 – 17 years
- ❖ Entrants must be sponsored by a business, club, association, or organisation within our community.

**Sponsorship fee of \$50 is required for each entrant. Each entrant can negotiate with their sponsor any further contributions towards clothing, floats, etc.*

- ❖ Entrants are required to make a short 1 – 2 minute video, introducing themselves, why they entered the Malanda Show Queen or Princess Competition, and what they enjoy about the Malanda Show. Please note, these videos will be posted to the Malanda Show Facebook page.
 - ❖ Entrants are required to submit or exhibit something in the show. This could be in the pavilion schedule or the outdoor schedule.
 - ❖ Entrants are expected to volunteer 10 hours for the Malanda Show. Some examples of volunteer opportunities. We can help organise volunteering hours if need be.
- *Be sure to wear your entrant sash to any volunteer events.*
- ❖ Show Queen & Princess Entrants (with help from their sponsor) are encouraged to organise a float or vehicle for the Friday night street procession. If entrants are unable to do so, they are expected to be seated at the marquees in front of the main grandstand by 7pm. Participation on Sunday in the Grand Parade is highly encouraged.
 - ❖ Winners may make a short acceptance speech on the night of the parade if they feel comfortable to do so.
