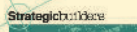

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND COMPETITION

1. ALL NOMINATIONS must be received by the Manager at the Show Office by closing date/time.
2. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
3. ALL birds to be penned by 8.30am Saturday of show for Judging at 9.00am Saturday.
4. Stewards will be accepting entries from 10.00am – 6.00pm Friday (for entries outside this time phone the Chief Steward to arrange a time).
5. Entries will close when the Pens are full. **A maximum of 25 birds per exhibitor will be enforced.**
6. NO sick or diseased birds are to be penned. **Any birds suspected of being sick will be inspected by a vet at the owner's expense.** All care but no responsibility taken for loss or damage to birds.
7. NO eggs are to be removed from the Pavilion without prior arrangement with the Chief Steward.
8. Cages will be secured until released by Steward.
9. Presentation time 12:00 midday Sunday and birds will be released after presentation of sashes and ribbons.

5G MALANDA SHOW POULTRY YOUNG JUDGES COMPETITION

This is a Malanda Show only competition and will be run following the guidelines of the State Competition, but the winner will not be eligible to go on to State Competitions.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Competitors must be aged between 15 and under 18 years of age as at the 1st of May in the year of the State Finals.
2. An Entry Form must be completed by all competitors.
3. Hormel Slide OR Computerised Judging Scoring System must be used.
4. Three (3) groups of four (4) birds of different breeds are to be used for judging.
5. Birds in each class will be numbered 1, 2, 3, 4.
6. The Competition is conducted in accordance with the Rules set by Agricultural Shows Australia (ASA) for National Finals. The Agricultural Shows Australia Rules (Handbooks) can be found on their website www.agshowsaustralia.org.au/member-resources/national-competitions-guidelines/
7. Visual Judging time will be six (6) minutes per class.
8. All competitors will complete a two-minute Oral speaking test per class.
9. The winner of the competition is marked out of a maximum of 100 points: 50 for the placings given in the visual class and 50 for the Oral Class.
10. Competitors in the Oral Class are scored on their accuracy of observation, their comparative statements, speaking ability and general presentation and dress.
11. In the case of a dead heat, the contestant with the highest points for visual judging will be declared the winner or if there is still a dead heat the over judge will have the final say.
