GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND COMPETITION

Weight for Age and Temperament will be important criteria!

1. All stock must be on the grounds by 3.00 p.m. FRIDAY 26th June, 2026 for penning and curfew. Stewards will be on the grounds from 12 noon onwards.
2. All cattle MUST remain penned until AFTER the grand parade (approx. 12.00) Sunday.
3. Exhibitors Passes: 2 per Exhibitor.
4. Only recognised Beef Breed **PASTURE FED** cattle may be entered.
5. **It is required that all cattle in this section be POLLED OR DEHORNED.**
6. All cattle must be bona fide property of the exhibitor and are to be exhibited free of disease and ticks.
7. The Judges' decision is final and in the event that an exhibit in any class is not worthy of a prize, no prize will be awarded.
8. No cattle are allowed as non-competitive.
9. **Cattle can be fed hay by exhibitors after Weighing is completed on Saturday morning (approx. 9am).** Feed will not be supplied by the Malanda Show Society.
10. **All cattle MUST be clearly numbered by the Exhibitor, preferably with an ear tag, so that it is obvious which class they are entered into.** Exhibitors are requested to pay particular attention to the filling in of their entry form and their NVD to ensure that they correctly supply all the information requested.
11. The Malanda Pastoral, Agricultural & Industrial Society Inc will not be responsible for any accident caused through, or by, an exhibit and will not under any circumstances hold itself responsible for any loss or mis-delivery of livestock or other exhibit of any kind, or for any damage done thereto.
12. All electrical leads must be tagged in accordance with the relevant industrial regulations.
13. This Show is conducted to the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution and the rules of this Society and any regulation which appears within the Schedule for individual sections of this Show. Should there be any conflict between the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution and the rules of this Society and any regulations appearing in this schedule, the rules and regulations of this Society shall prevail. All persons, upon entering any class in this schedule agree to indemnify the Malanda Pastoral, Agricultural & Industrial Society Inc, against liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to any exhibit. Exhibitor or Competitor agrees that all competitions are under the complete and total control of the Malanda Pastoral, Agricultural & Industrial Society Inc. whose decision in all matters is final.
14. Single Bullock & Heifer Entries (Classes 7, 8 & 9) can't come from Pen of Three Entries (Classes 1, 2 & 3).
15. All cattle entries MUST be four teeth and less.

There is a section on the entry form where Exhibitors can note if Cattle are to be sold so that the Stewards are aware of this, however it is not the responsibility of the Malanda Show or the Stewards to prepare the Cattle for transport. Cattle returning to the Exhibitors can be collected after the Grand Parade on Sunday and any cattle sold can be transported by Body Truck after 12 Noon on Sunday.

The cattle being exhibited at the Show are noted as "Being sighted" at the Malanda Showgrounds on the NLIS database, so it will be up to the Exhibitor to organise a separate NVD for any Cattle sold to Cross Custom Meats.

ALL CATTLE MUST HAVE NLIS TAGS FITTED, WHICH WILL BE SCANNED ON ARRIVAL AT THE SHOWGROUNDS.

A COPY OF YOUR NVD IS REQUIRED TO BE HANDED TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THE END OF THE SHOW. – Destination to be completed as:- Malanda Showgrounds and return.
